

# Pure Storage hits a home run with the Junior Giants

This donation will cover league fees and equipment costs for 2,000 local girls and boys who love baseball and help further the Junior Giants' mission of providing a free, non-competitive program in underserved communities that teaches important values and life skills through baseball.
